4S - SRI LANKA

It will be a "holiday style" operation using two stations, with amplifiers, on 40-6 meters, CW/SSB/RTTY. The team includes Heida (YL) DK1MA; Sid, DM2AYO; Rolf, DL7VEE; Dietman, DL2HWA; Werner, DJ9KH; George, DL4SVA; Norbert, DL2RNS; Guenter, DL2AWG; Klaus, DK1AX & Juergen, DL3HRH.

PLEASE NOTE: We do not accept IRCs. LoTW upload and bureau cards (OQRS preferred) 6 months after the expedition.

Ernoe, DK2AMM; Hans, DL6JGN; Tom, GM4FDM and Ronald, PA3EWP will be here March 3-15 as **TX7EU**. They will work 40-10 on W/SSB/Digital modes. QL via DK2AMM. OQRS will be available at: <<http://www.marquesas2016.de>>.

S9BK - SAO TOME & PRINCIPE

Bruno, HB9BEI expects to be here February 25 to March 25. It will be a one man "holiday style" DXpedition. He may stay longer but that is not certain.; He plans to work 40-10 SSB/Digital modes. He says he won't "annoy the DX community with my bad CW." QSL to home call.

T32 - EAST KIRIBATI (Christmas Island)

A seven member team consisting of KG8CO/T32CO; N6FS/T32FS; N8LJ/T32LJ; K8MU/T32MU; K8QKY/T32SB; K8AQM/T32TR and AC8W/T32WW will be here March 1-16. They will work 160-10 on CW/SSB/Digital modes with four stations. For the ARRL SSB contest they will use **T32WW**. QSL for ALL callsigns to AC8JF direct: US stations include SASE. Others send an SAE with \$2-USD or VALID IRC. You can also use the bureau via AC8JF. The log will be uploaded to LoTW. Log search will be on ClubLog, and you can also use the OQRS there.

V7 - MARSHALL ISL

OPDX reports Jim, AH6OY will be going to Majuro Island March 1-7 where he plans to operate in the ARRL SSB contest. His callsign has not yet been assigned. Outside of the contest he reportedly will work SSB/CW/RTTY and JT65. No QSL info, listen for instructions on that.

★ **OC-243 - BREAKSEA ISL (VK6):** Andy, VK5MAV; Craig, VK5CE and perhaps one more, will be active as homecall/6, March 1-8. They plan to run two stations on 40-10 with Andy on CW and Craig on SSB. QSL to the respective home call, direct, bureau or use ClubLog OR. See QRZ.com for more details or visit the blog: <<http://oc243.blogspot.com.au>>. This IOTA has only been activated one time, in 2001.

★ **3W2BR - VIETNAM:** Herbert, DK2BR will operate from Con Son Island (AS-130) March 5-21. He will operate "holiday style" with an IC706 and a vertical on 40-10 using SSB/RTTY and perhaps PSK31. QSL direct ONLY to home call and include \$2-USD. He is NOT a member of DARC so DO NOT send via their bureau.

★ **5X1XA - UGANDA:** Alan, G3XAQ will be here again, but from a new QTH March 4-16. He typically works 80-10 CW only. This time his primary focus is for the RSGB Commonwealth - BERU - Contest. QSL via G3SWH, OQRS or LoTW.

★ **8R1A - GUYANA:** Alex, W1CDC will be going to Guyana again, April 11-24. It is NOT a DXpedition, but "holiday style" CW only. He will work SSB only for local nets. Alex will work 80-10 with an FCT-450, MFJ 905 tuner and G5RV antenna. QSL to home call: US stations with SASE and All other an SAE with \$2-USD. Please NO coins, stamps or IRC's.

★ **C9 - MOZAMBIQUE:** Arkady, UA4CC/C92CC and Arunas, LY2IJ/C91IJ will be here February 28 to March 7. They plan to work the HF Bands focusing on the low bands. QSL to the respective home call or use ClubLog OQRS or LoTW.

★ **D2/CT1ITE ANGOLA:** Paulo will be active here until the end of March. He will operate in his spare time on 80-10- CW/SSB. QSL to home call.

★ **FG - GUADELOUPE:** Gildas, F6HMQ and Michel, F6GWV will be active February 26-March 14. They will use the call **TO66R** for the ARRL SSB contest and outside the contest will use FG/homecall, for those contacts QSL to the respective home call. For TO66R, QSL via F6HMQ.

★ **HC1WDT - ECUADOR:** Bill, WØOR will be active from Cotacachi March 2 to April 29. He will work 80-10 mostly CW with some RTTY. He will work the ARRL SSB contest. QSL direct to home call or use LoTW.

★ **HP3VY2SS - PANAMA:** George, K8GG reports Robby is on an assignment in western Panama and will be putting up a yagi and dipoles for the low bands. No indication how long he will be there. He was active in the ARRL contest over the past weekend. QSL via AC2OV only as shown on QRZ.com.

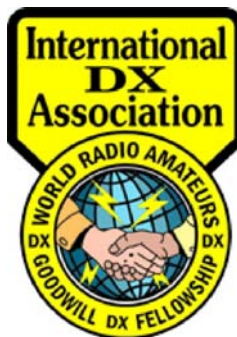
